Announcement of Udonthani Communicable Disease Committee

Measures on Surveillance, Prevention, and Control of Coronavirus Disease Infection 2019 (COVID-19)

Udonthani Province

No. 3 dated 22 March 2020

According to the endorsement of the Cabinet meeting on 17 March 2020, by virtue of section 22(7), 34, 35, 36, 37 and 38 of the Communicable Disease Act B.E. 2555, and due to the acceleration of the current situation of COVID-19 pandemic, the Governor of Udonthani, with approval of the Udonthani Communicable Disease Committee in the 6th Meeting on 22 March 2020, approves the announcement of temporary closure of the premises, No. 3 on 22 March 2020, as follows:

Article 1 Implement community measures to temporarily close the premises according to the announcement of the Udonthani Communicable Disease Committee on measures on surveillance, prevention, and control of COVID-19, No. 2 on 20 March 2020

Article 2 Temporarily close the premises in Udonthani until the situation is resolved during 22 March - 12 April 2020 as follows:

- 1) educational institutions at all levels and tutorial schools
- 2) exhibition centers, convention centers, and exhibition venues
- 3) shopping malls, shopping centers, large retail stores or stores with sub-stores in the same building or area, except for banks, supermarkets, pharmacies, or miscellaneous goods necessary for living, and restaurants (allow to open only for take away)
- 4) markets and flea markets (allow to open only for selling fresh food, dried food, ready meal for take away, animal food, pharmacies, and miscellaneous goods necessary for living) and walking street
- 5) restaurants, beverage stores (allow to open only for selling food and beverages for take away and restaurants in hotels that serve only the hotel guests) except restaurants and beverage stores in hospitals which must arrange individual seats and queue spacing of at least 1 meter or more (social distancing) in accordance with the guidelines to prevent the spread of infection

- 6) convenience stores, restaurants, and beverage stores, to continue operation, must arrange seating/standing area and queue spacing of at least 1 meter or more (social distancing) in accordance with the guidelines to prevent spreading of infection
- 7) pubs, entertainment centers, and service-providing venues and the like, including places that sell and distribute alcoholic beverages to consume in that place
 - 8) health-related enterprises
 - 9) bath and massage parlors (except those in medical facilities)
 - 10) parlors for bathing, steam bath, and herbal steam bath (except those in medical facilities)
 - 11) beauty salon, hair salon, and haircut venues
 - 12) tattoo or skin piercing shops
 - 13) weight control clinics and beauty clinics (except specialized skin clinics)
- 14) animal service facilities (spa, bathing, hair cutting, pet boarding) (except for medical treatment in animal hospitals)
- 15) swimming pools, including the swimming pools of the villages or residential condominiums, water parks
 - 16) gyms and fitness centers of all types, including fitness facilities in residential condominiums
 - 17) skating and roller blading parks/rinks and the like
 - 18) indoor and outdoor playgrounds or amusement parks
 - 19) game shops, internet shops, and game cabinets
 - 20) karaoke shops
 - 21) cinemas and theaters
 - 22) Buddha amulets and statues markets, including those in the temples
 - 23) Integrated Government Service Center in Udon Thani Province (Central Plaza Udon Thani)
 - 24) golf courses or golf practice fields/driving ranges
 - 25) shooting ranges and archery fields
 - 26) fishing/shrimp fishing including other similar activities

- 27) sports stadiums including tennis courts, badminton courts, football fields, futsal fields, etc. (except for solo exercise such as walking or jogging)
 - 28) snooker, billiards, and bowling facilities
- 29) boxing stadiums, boxing schools, boxing camps, martial arts (such as Taekwondo, Judo, etc.) schools and martial arts practicing venues
- 30) horse-racing courses, chicken fighting fields, chicken fighting practice fields, fighting fish fields, auto racing arena
 - 31) cattle and buffalo markets
- 32) tourist attractions such as Udon Thani City Museum, Ban Chiang National Museum, Thai-Chinese Cultural Center (San Chao Pu Ya) and Kham Chanod (all parts, both inside and outside)
 - 33) places to watch boxing in the villages
- 34) arrange for screening inbound bus passengers traveling from Bangkok and its surrounding provinces at Non Sa-at district checkpoint.

According to Article 52 of the Communicable Disease Act B.E. 2558, all violators or non-compliance shall be liable to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one (1) year or a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand baht or both.
